## Announcement to CCOC January 14, 2022

## **Draft Charge**:

For over two decades, The University of Alabama's Core Curriculum Oversight Committee (CCOC) has monitored the implementation of the university's Core Curriculum based on guidelines that were last reaffirmed in 2015. Per those guidelines and best practices in curricular development and implementation, the CCOC is expected to engage in regular review of all aspects of the Core Curriculum. The Executive Vice President and Provost is expected to initiate this review every five years. Per these responsibilities, Executive Vice President and Provost Jim Dalton authorizes and requests current chair of the CCOC Dr. Derek Williamson to form a subcommittee to review the Guidelines for the Core Curriculum Oversight Committee and to recommend changes as necessary. It is expected that this review will consider, at a minimum, current practices in core course review and designation, regular assessment of institutional student learning outcome to determine the effectiveness of core (general education) requirements, a well-defined process for identifying, approving, and implementing structural changes to the Core, and a more effective and efficient organizational structure for continued maintenance of a quality general education experience for UA's students.
