From 1985 to 1993 Timothy McBride served in the Reagan and Bush Administrations as Personal Aide to the Vice President, later President, George H.W. Bush. He was confirmed by the U.S. Senate as Assistant Secretary of Commerce for international trade in 1990. He returned to the White House in 1991 to serve as Assistant to the President for Management & Administration and the White House Military Office.

McBride is currently President & Chairman of ST Engineering North American. ST Engineering, a Singaporean company which has operated in the United States since 2001, owns & operates a dozen defense and commercial businesses in

the United States. McBride previously led global government affairs at United Technologies Corporation (later Raytheon Technologies), Covidien (a medical device manufacturer later acquired by Medtronic). McBride held similar position at other companies, including Sunoco, Chrysler (later DaimlerChrysler), and Freddie Mac.

He is a member of the U.S.-Afghan Women's Council and is a co-founder of the Ayenda Foundation, a nonprofit established to improve the lives of Afghan children. McBride is also a member of the George H.W. Bush Presidential Museum & Library Advisory Board. He is married to Anita Bevacqua McBride. They reside in Washington DC and have two children.
